

# Ozaukee County Fish & Game Association Rifle Range Rules (Revised 02/2012)

---

- 1) Sign-in required by all using the Rifle Range and Trap Field. Sign-in Book located in the wooden box hanging in the center of the bench area.
  - A. Keep the front gate open while on site.
  - B. Keep your Club Issues Membership Card with you while at the club. You may be asked to produce it. If you are not able to, you may be asked to leave club property.
- 2) Hours of Operation – 9:00 A.M. to Dusk.
  - A. All shooting is to be done from the concrete pad. If no one else is present on the range you can shoot at the 25 yard pistol target (far south target board) from less than 25 yards.
- 3) Rifle Range will be closed as follows:
  - A. The two weekends prior to the opening of the Wisconsin Gun Deer Season (Sight-in).
  - B. During Trap Leagues, Merchandize Shoots and Sporting Clays events (Friday/Saturday/Sunday of Sporting Clays)
  - C. During Special Events when the grounds are being used. Example; Banquets/Hunter Safety/Hunter Training. A notice announcing Special Events will be posted on the range and included in your mailings. Also, you can check for closures on [www.OZCFG.com](http://www.OZCFG.com).
- 4) The range can be used by all Hunting, Associate, Gold, Honorary and General Members. One person at a time of the member's immediate family may be a guest with the range member present.

Exception: Up to two children of the member's immediate family may be a guest at the same time.

- Children must be in school, supervised at the bench/waiting behind; no running around; are to be supervised at all times.

Members and their guests are to use one bench as a courtesy to others. Guests, other than family members, may not use the range without prior permission of one of The Board of Directors.

- The group which arrived first has the authority to call rules! Example; Ceasefire/Open Actions/Resume.

- 5) Automatic weapons, any semi-automatic weapon adjusted to increase its cyclic rate of fire, tracer ammunition and any weapon or ammunition termed illegal by State or Federal law is prohibited.
- 6) All expended brass is to be cleaned up and placed in the proper container upon completion of shooting.
  - A. Any unspent rounds should be properly disposed of by the member and not placed into the expended brass containers.
- 7) All targets are to be removed when done shooting.
- 8) All shooting is to be into the berm back stops.

DO NOT SHOOT THE GROUND AS THIS CAUSES RICOCHETS.

- 9) DO NOT shoot up the wooden target board frames.
- 10) Use only PAPER TARGETS! (Hang from lower half of board to prevent rounds from sailing over the berm).
- 11) Use single wireframe target board for patterning shotgun. DO NOT use any other target boards for patterning shotguns!
- 12) Observe posted rules on the range.  
Anyone failing to comply with the range rules or acting in an unsafe manner can have their membership terminated!
- 13) Use the trap range permitted with members own equipment. All shooting to be in the same direction as the trap range.
  - A. Rifle range supersedes trap range. Example; If people are using or come to use the rifle range, trap shooting stops.
- 14) Pistol shooting at 25 Yard target (far south board). If no one else is present on the range you can shoot at the 25 yard pistol target (far south target board) from less than 25 yards.
